

Symbols in the map support

Function	Symbol	Description
Search	Find address or place	Search for a specific location in Sweden. You can search for such as places, lakes or coordinate points in WGS84 (gps coordinates). The search function gives a more accurate result if you are already zoomed in near the place you are looking for. If you want to find Stortorget in Gävle, you search for Gävle, Stortorget. If you do not get any results, it may be because you are zoomed out too far in the map. If so, click on the standard map view to zoom in so that you can see all of Sweden.
Shown as an option when you activate the search function	Use current location	Zooms in to your current location. You need to allow the browser to use your location if you want to use this function.
Zoom in	+	Enlarges the map image.
Zoom out		Scales down the map image.
Default map view	6	Zooms out/in the map to a view of all of Sweden.
Show the help text	?	Displays a short help text on how to use the map support and perform easier searches with the search tool.
Get coordinates from files	0	Are your photos geotagged? You can use this feature to automatically place points on the map at the locations you have photographed.
Change map layer		Select background map. You can choose between a map view and an orthophoto (aerial view). You can turn on and off the display of property divisions and your plotted points, polygons and rectangles. Available layers: Drawing, property division,
		orthophoto, topographic web map. The map layer of property division is only shown from a scale of 1,50,000 and on larger scale.
Select a geo- object	\bowtie	from a scale of 1:50,000 and on larger scale. Select the object you want to change or delete.

Function	Symbol	Description
Select by using a rectangle	72	Mark with a rectangle the object or area of drawings that you want to change or delete.
Select by using free hand (lasso)	Q	Select freely with a lasso the object or area of drawings that you want to change or delete.
Draw a point	0	Place a point that marks the location you have focused on in the material. Used, for example, to mark a house that you have photographed.
Polygon		Draw an area on which you have focused.
Rectangle		Draw an area on which you have focused. Click, hold and drag to choose how big the area should be or double-click in the map to get a predetermined size of the area.
Undo	\leftarrow	Is only active when drawing alternative editing a point, polygon or rectangle.
Repeat	ightharpoons	Is only active when drawing alternative editing a point, polygon or rectangle.
Drawings	Drawings (Point): 1 (Polygon): 2 (Polygon): 3	Displays all plotted objects on the map. Plotted objects are shown as the type of object in parentheses followed by an identification number. A GPS-tagged photo that has been added is shown as (Location): File name.
Clear the map	Clear the map	Deletes all plotted objects on the map.
Save	Save	Saves your drawn map sketch on the application and closes the map support.
Delete items	Ü	Only active if point or polygon/rectangle is selected.
